**PRODUCT DATA SHEET**

<b>Product</b>	<b>Surface Cleaner</b>
<b>Type</b>	Blend of powerful solvents formulated to remove grime and wax.
<b>Intended Use</b>	Ideal for use on antique and old furniture where wax and dirt has accumulated.
<b>Special Features</b>	Will not destroy attractive patina that has been acquired due to age.
<b>Preparation</b>	Ensure gloves and eye protection are worn and that there is adequate ventilation.
<b>Application</b>	Apply the cleaner with a soft cloth, or if the wood is very dirty, use 0000 steel wool. If the wood is open grained use a coarser grade of steel wool. Wipe the surface with a clean rag or kitchen towel whilst the surface is still wet otherwise the cleaner will evaporate re-depositing the wax and dirt on the furniture.
<b>Coats</b>	N/A
<b>Drying Time</b>	The surface that has been cleaned should be dry within 90 minutes.
<b>Re-coating Time</b>	Once the surface is dry then it is ready for coating or waxing.
<b>Application Temp.</b>	Ideally 10-25°C.
<b>Coverage</b>	N/A
<b>Maintenance</b>	N/A
<b>Compatibility</b>	If after cleaning, the surface is dull but intact, the gloss may be restored with <b>Rustin's Finish Reviver</b> which will also remove minor defects.
<b>Settlement</b>	Shake before use.
<b>Shelf-life/Storage</b>	A considerable period of time provided the product is stored in an airtight and container. It is preferable to store the product in a cool place and ensure that the cap is replaced.
<b>Hazards</b>	Flammable. Harmful; may cause lung damage if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from sources of ignition- no smoking. Do not breathe vapour. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of fire use foam/dry powder/co2- never use water.
